- **READ, COMPLETE, and SUBMIT** the audition application by Thursday February 17, 2022

1st & 2nd Grade

Students in grades 5-8 have options. They will be split into several performing groups and can choose from two different song lists (see above).

- **BRING your completed application to the front office by Thursday February 17, 2022.**
 - You will receive an email with an approximate audition time.
 - Auditions will be open and in small groups (see details below).
- **Grades 1, 3, 5, 7** – Tuesday February 22 starting at 2:05pm, Middle School STEM LAB (SCLC building)
- **Grades 2, 4, 6, 8** - Wednesday February 23, starting at 2:05pm, Middle School STEM LAB (SCLC building)

- **PARTICIPATION FEE** is \$250 per cast member. This fee is due by February 28, 2022
- A link will be sent with the Audition time for payments, FACTS payments will be utilized
 - >Each participation fee includes a DVD of the performance. An option will be available to remove \$30 per additional child's participation fee. Please contact Janess Sifers with further questions on payments.
 - >This fee covers costumes, sets/props, music, lighting, sound, licensing, cast t-shirt, DVD, snacks, the cast party, and much more.
- **Open Audition Information**
 - students will audition in groups of three to four. They will be called in and asked to dance as a group then sing their songs individually.
 - Parents need to stay with students until their audition is complete.
 - Parents may come into the audition room and sit quietly while children audition or wait outside.
 - Please do not bring siblings into the audition room if they will be disruptive.
 - Students will only receive one audition time slot.
 - Applicants may leave as soon as they have auditioned.
- **All Performances and Tech week are MANDATORY!**
 - >Rehearsal (Mandatory): Friday March 25 during the day (no school this day), Time TBA
 - >Rehearsal (Mandatory): Saturday March 26 during the day, Time TBA
 - >Tech Week (Mandatory): March 28-31 after school until approximately 6:30pm
 - >Performance #1 (Mandatory): April 1, 4:30pm calltime, 6:30pm show
 - >Performance #2 (Mandatory): April 2, 11:00am call time, 1:00pm show
 - >Performance #3 (Mandatory): April 2, 4:30pm call time, 6:30pm show
 - >STRIKE the SHOW (Mandatory): April 2 after the last performance
 - >Cast Party TBA

COSTUMES:

**Costumes remain the property of SJSC for use in future productions.*

**Students will be asked to provide basic costume items such as shoes or tank tops. Personal items will be returned.*

REHEARSAL INFO: Rehearsals will be Mondays, Tuesday, and Wednesdays after school. Each group/grade level will have two rehearsals per week leading up to Tech Week.

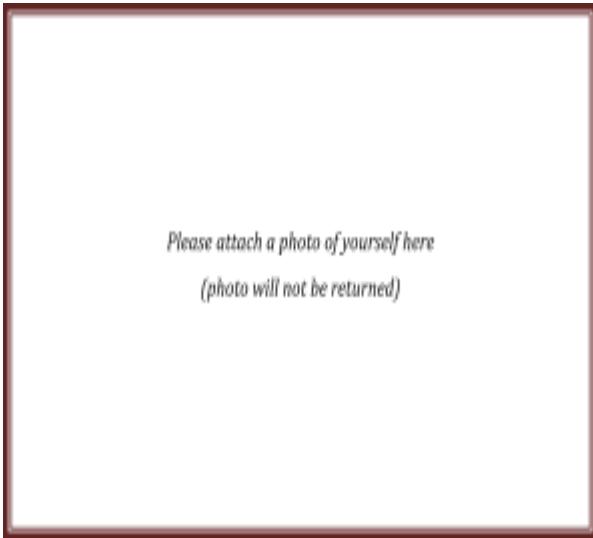
Audition Application ~ Medley of Musicals

CAST & CREW ELIGIBILITY CONTRACT

As educators, we have a responsibility to see that academics are the number one priority for students participating in the Spring Musical. Students participating in *Medley of Musicals*. will assume the responsibility of obtaining and completing all academic assignments. The following policies are established to help and ensure that the cast and crew members involved in a *Medley of Musicals* program meet SJSC's high academic standards.

1. All students participating in SJSC's Spring Musical *Medley of Musicals* are expected to uphold Responsible Behavior or they will be asked to leave the musical. Students who have numerous detentions will have a conference with the director to decide if the musical is something that should be continued.
2. The administration reserves the right to remove a cast or crew member from the musical either temporarily or permanently if, in the opinion of the administration, the student demonstrates poor behavior or citizenship during the school day or at musical rehearsal or if the student does not meet the academic and conduct requirements as stated above.
3. A student will not be dismissed from an after-school detention in order to make musical rehearsal.
- 4. For a cast or crew member to be eligible to participate in that day's rehearsal and/or performance they must have attended class for 1/2 a day (*students must arrive to school by 11:00am*).**
5. Students will be allowed ***ONE unexcused absences*** during the rehearsal schedule (not including mandatory rehearsals/performances). Students who miss more than the allotted ONE rehearsals will face the following disciplinary action(s) at SJSC's discretion. Such action may include, but are not limited to the following:
 - a) Meeting with Mrs. Sifers
 - b) Be removed from a song
 - c) Dismissal from the musical
6. An Audition Application, Eligibility Contract, and payment must be submitted to the Musical Director before a student can attend musical rehearsals and performances.
