Learning Support and Psychological Services

- Providing consultation to teachers and families regarding academic concerns
- Ensuring that exceptional needs are met by way of our Individualized Learning Plans (ILPs)
- Coordinating ILP team meetings at least annually to update student goals and areas of development
- Working with principals and assistant principals to incorporate ILP accommodations and modifications into school-wide practices
- Attending public school IEP/504 meetings and working with local district providers to ensure the delivery of student service plans
- Interpreting formal and informal cognitive and psychological assessments and incorporating into ILP plan
- Providing consultation to teachers and families about social-emotional/behavioral concerns
- Counseling individuals or groups to address social-emotional/behavioral needs
- Serving as an active member of Serra's Learning Support Team
- Collaborating with administration to implement school-wide systems for student success, and exercise data-based decision making
