STRATEGIC GOAL ONE Catholic Identity

GOAL: Continue to strengthen the partnership with parishes to align campus evangelization with the faith community. We plan to focus on this by increasing the priests' presence on campus and having Serra's mission shared during Sunday services and parish communications.

ACTION ITEM:

Invite the parishes to attend on-campus events one time per month.

- Invite Parishioners, through continual quarterly insert in parish bulletin, to monthly Mass
- Bishop invited to celebrate Mass once a year
- · Donors invited

ACTION ITEM:

Execute at least one announcement per month in each parish bulletin (print or video)

ACTION ITEM:

Schedule St. Serra Choir performance at parish two or three times per school year, specifically during:

- · Catholic Schools Week
- Christmas season

ACTION ITEM:

Increase St. Serra presence at parishes

- Organize Serra parent group to host an outreach table after Sunday mass one time per trimester.
- St. Serra school listed in Parish bulletins.



STRATEGIC GOAL TWO

Academic Excellence + Whole Child Wellness

GOAL: Offer a top-tier Catholic education that rivals neighboring schools in Orange County by implementing a proactive and whole-child approach to nurture our students academically and emotionally.

ACTION ITEM:

Collect academic data to guide the child's educational journey.


- Collect post-Serra data that follows our alumni and illustrates that the competitive Catholic high schools in Orange County accept 99% of our graduates.
- Gather alumni academic data. The goal is to maintain the historical average.
- Collect multiple data points (such as standardized tests, teacher evaluation, grades, personality, etc.) to determine a customized educational path for our students.

ACTION ITEM:

Allocate resources toward our students' emotional wellness.

- One full-time on-campus counselor
- Implement MTSS Multi-Tier Support System
- Launch a social-emotional learning curriculum in 2023-24
- Present four parent-speaker series events per school year





ACTION ITEM:

Continual focus on extracurricular activities such as Athletics, Performing Arts, and Leadership clubs as a critical part of the development of the whole child.

ACTION ITEM:

Continue to differentiate St. Serra from other competitor schools by offering rigorous curriculum that allows all students to reach their full potential.

- Varied instruction in ELA and Math
- Tailored lessons based on student needs
- Differentiated learning for academic success

ACTION ITEM:

Focus on finding qualified teachers/staff who align with our school's mission, vision, and philosophy.

- Recruit and retain credentialed teachers and outstanding administrators.
- Offer our teachers weekly professional development to support continual growth in curriculum implementation and technological advancements, and ensure consistency in execution across classes. Teachers have ongoing professional development and tailor lessons based on student needs. Dynamic data-driven process.

ACTION ITEM:


Retain a full-time, on-campus security guard.
