Welcome back! I am so excited to begin another great year of singing, praying, and group activities with your child(ren). Activities this year will include having the students singing at Mass Celebrations, the Harvest Festival, Assisted Living Homes, the Christmas Concert, the Spring Concert and participating in a Disneyland Performing Arts workshop!

Rehearsals for the 2019-2020 school year will be held **Tuesday and Thursday AFTERNOONS**, **from 2:45 - 3:30 pm**. All rehearsals are scheduled to take place in the **PEB Music Room**. Rehearsals will be vital for us to complete the huge amount of music the students will be learning.

Guidelines and Member Expectations

- 1) Candidate Requirements and Selection Process: The Serra Singers is open to 3rd and 4th grade students. No audition is necessary to be in the ensemble. Voice classification will be assessed to assign proper parts.
- 2) Rehearsal Schedule: Tuesday and Thursday <u>AFTERNOONS</u> from 2:45 3:30 pm. All rehearsals are scheduled to take place in the PEB Music room. Students are to report directly after dismissal. Warm ups and attendance start at 2:45 pm sharp. Student pick up after school will be in front of the PEB, at 3:35 pm. You are also welcome to enter through the Extended Care gate and meet your student by Extended Care. <u>Students who are not picked up by 3:45 pm will be signed in to Extended Care (fees apply).</u>
- 3) Attendance: Every individual voice in our choir is equally important to the total unified sound. Frequent absences or tardiness diminish the success of the group. It is also harmful to our vocal cords if we miss warm ups due to arriving late. Many of our rehearsals will be fast paced, covering a lot of music, as performances happen close to one another. If your student will be absent, please contact Ms. Armenta prior to rehearsal at parmenta@serraschool.org or 949-888-1990 x172. Illness is considered an excused absence. A note from parent/guardian is required. Choir is a year-long commitment. Attendance will be taken at each rehearsal. Each student is allowed 2 unexcused absences per trimester. Please be on time. Please note that two tardies will count as an unexcused absence. Students MUST attend the 2 rehearsals before a performance in order to perform with the choir.
- 4) **Concert and Mass Schedule:** This schedule will be sent through email. Information can also be accessed by going to Serraschool.org and clicking on Campus Life > Choir/Handbells.

- 6) **Behavior:** Students are expected to follow the Serra Catholic School Code of Conduct at all times.
- 7) Choir Participation Fee: This non-refundable fee will be collected from every participant to offset the expenses incurred by the school for this extra-curricular program. These funds will be used for the purchase of music, musical accompaniment, choir T-Shirts, musical instruction, and the Disneyland workshop. The fee for the 2019-2020 choir participation fee is \$250.00 per student and will be due by Friday October 4th. Please make checks payable to SJSC, attention Ms. Armenta. Checks may be dropped off at the school office or sent with your student to their classroom.
- 8) Parent Support: Volunteer opportunities include: chaperones, parent drivers, and party coordinators. If interested, please email Ms. Armenta at parmenta@serraschool.org or call (949) 888-1990 ext. 172. *If you would like to be a chaperone for the Disneyland event you can email me anytime. We will only be able to take a limited number of parent chaperones. Chaperones MUST ride to and from Disneyland with the buses. It is strictly against Diocesan Safe Environment policy for non-chaperone parents and family members to "meet up" during any school sanctioned events.
